The Club was not just an after-school program for me. It was a safe haven. A place for me to learn, socialize and be myself.

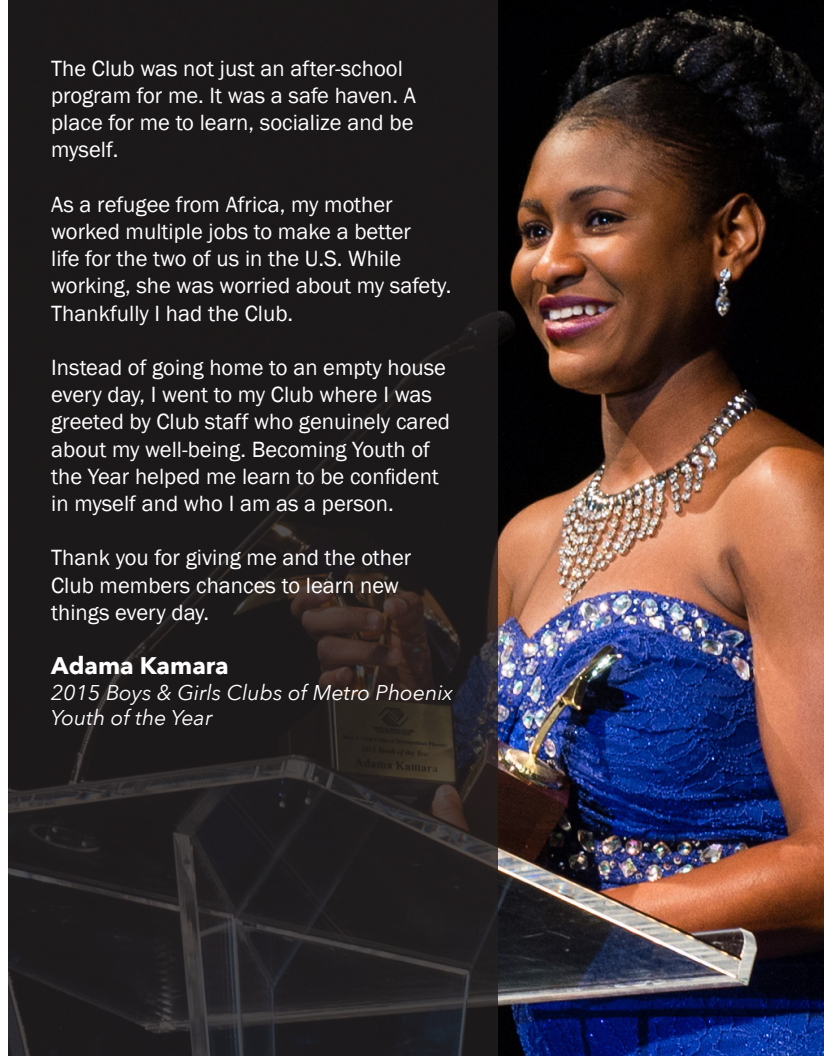

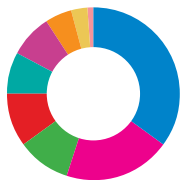
