

StrataTech Women in Trades Boys and Girls Club of Arizona Scholarship Program

This scholarship program is designed to provide financial assistance to eligible students with. All prospective/enrolled students meeting the stated criteria will be eligible for consideration. The criteria have been designed to give the Scholarship Selection Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- be enrolled in an eligible program and start before Sept 30, 2023;
- be a U. S. citizen or permanent resident;
- must be a female student of the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Valley member;
- must provide proof of Boys & Girls Clubs of the Valley Program participation;
- complete a Scholarship Request Form;
- have no lapse in proper registration or break in attendance; and
- maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Awarding Process and Rules

- Scholarships are not transferable or renewable.
- Only one award from this scholarship program will be given.
- Scholarships will be distributed incrementally over the student's first academic year.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date or shift, the scholarship award may be forfeited. Scholarships are not transferable or renewable. This scholarship may be used in conjunction with other institutional scholarship programs, but cannot exceed the direct educational program costs.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarship award amount is up to \$10,000.

**All scholarship amounts are calculated based on by established guidelines. StrataTech Education Group reserves the right to cancel a scholarship program at any time. However, all scholarships that have been awarded will be honored provided the student continues to meet the eligibility requirements.*

The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final.

Our Policy

Any student meeting the scholarship criteria may apply. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. This scholarship is not transferrable. It will be applied incrementally to the student's account over the 1st year of the student's academic program. The maximum award is \$10,000.

Students must complete this request form and submit it to the Scholarship Selection Committee to be considered. Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed based on the awarding process and rules.

This scholarship program is based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.

The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee will be final.
