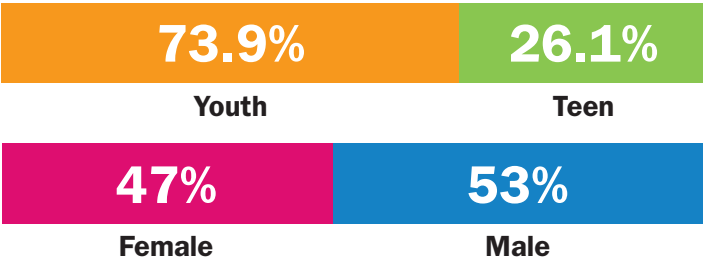
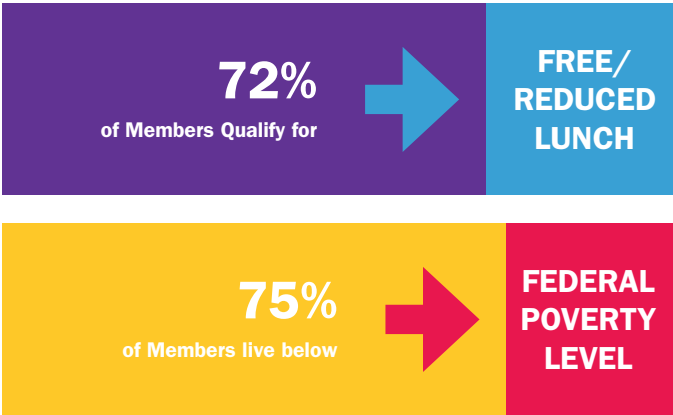

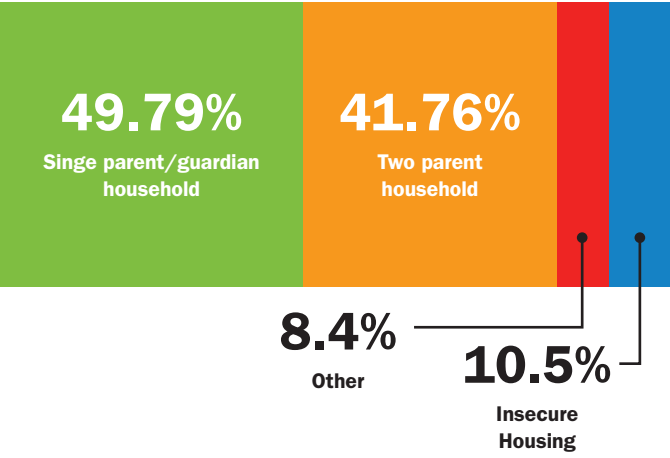

At Boys & Girls Clubs of the Valley, we go beyond after-school care—we build healthy futures. Every day, our members engage in physical activity, learn to make nutritious choices, and gain the confidence to avoid risky behaviors.

Our Clubs are designed to foster not only physical wellness, but also emotional resilience. Working with our Wellness Coaches, youth and teens are learning programs, youth develop essential life skills: empathy, emotional regulation, self-management, and positive decision-making.

\$22.4 million: Estimated lifetime savings from increased physical activity among BGCAZ youth in 2025—demonstrating that active kids grow into healthier, more productive adults.

Every Club provides free, nutritious meals and snacks through the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and Summer Food Service Program (SFSP).

Daily gym time, team sports, and wellness activities ensure all members have access to structured movement and the tools to lead a healthy lifestyle.



Every \$1 invested in BGCAZ operations in FY 2024-25, \$14.79 in benefits were generated—totaling \$398.5 million in socio-economic value.

Academic Success: Empowering Youth to Graduate with Purpose

At Boys & Girls Clubs of the Valley, we believe that every young person deserves the opportunity to succeed in school and in life. Our programs are designed to keep youth on track to graduate, prepared for college, career, and the future.

- **95%** of Club teens are estimated to graduate from high school—6.46 percentage points higher than the average across the 12 school districts we serve.
- BGCAZ's academic support, mentoring, and enrichment programs give students the tools to thrive. From homework help to STEM challenges to college readiness, **we help close the opportunity gap.**

- **\$14.9 million** – That's the estimated lifetime earnings gain for BGCAZ members who are now more likely to graduate high school—an investment in brighter futures and stronger communities.

Addressing Arizona's Mental Health Crisis

The WCA Whole Child Approach program tackles Arizona's youth mental health emergency head-on. With anxiety diagnoses up 55% and depression nearly doubling (97% increase), Arizona ranks 50th nationally for youth mental health. Our comprehensive program addresses emotional, physical, social, and nutritional needs through integrated wellness coaching, mindfulness training, and behavioral health support, providing critical intervention where 67% of youth with depression receive no mental health services.

Our dedicated team combines evidence-based practices like Qigong, breathing techniques, and nutritional education to help children develop essential life skills. With direct partnerships to Terros Health for counseling referrals and staff trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid, we provide both immediate crisis support and long-term resilience building in communities where families face significant barriers to traditional mental health care.

Whole Child Approach Fast Facts & Impact Highlights

- **10,000+** youth served across 24 Club locations through 7,000+ mental wellness sessions
- **350+ staff trained** in Youth Mental Health First Aid (150 full-time, 200+ part-time)
- **Expanding to 30 sites** by October 2025, reaching 15,000+ youth annually
- **Crisis intervention:** Direct Terros Health referrals for professional counseling support
- **Family integration:** Wellness practices extend beyond Club walls to strengthen entire households
